Students are encouraged to maximize their experience at UTSA by accessing the credit that can be received through prior learning experiences such as, the Advanced Placement (AP) program, College Level Examination Program (CLEP), Competency Based Exams (CBE), Dantes (DSST), International Baccalaureate Diploma (IBD), International Baccalaureate Certificate (IBC), and SAT Subject Tests. The following tables provide information on minimum scores required in order to receive credit at UTSA. There are University policies that may affect whether or not credit can be received through these tests. The cut-off scores displayed on the tables are valid beginning August 1, 2018. These scores and course credits are subject to change without notice.

Advanced Placement (AP):

UTSA accepts many Advanced Placement (AP) exams for college credit. Students who score high enough on College Board AP exams may be exempt from taking courses that otherwise may be required of them. Advanced Placement (AP) Examinations are not administered on the UTSA campus.

Dantes exams taken prior to January 1, 2004 are not accepted for credit at UTSA.

To be eligible to receive UTSA credit for the Dantes exams, a student must have earned no college or university transcript credit in that subject area at the time he or she takes the exam. Although it is not necessary to be a UTSA student to take a national Dantes exam through the UTSA Testing Services office, no UTSA credit is awarded until the individual is registered for courses at UTSA.

UTSA is an “open” DSST test center. If not seeking to earn credit at UTSA, please review your institution’s Credit by Exam policies before registering for a national Dantes exam.

You must wait at least 30 days before re-taking a Dantes exam.
