This course provides an introduction to the period of struggle in American history known as the Civil Rights Movement. The objective is to survey the major historical figures, organizations,

locations, strategies and ideas that coalesce to make the history of the movement. The course will analyze the historical trajectory of educational policies with particular emphasis on the

*Brown v. Board of Education* decision in 1954 and its implications over the following 20 years, as well as the origins and recent developments of the Black Lives Matter movement.
