BE INFORMED	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Review your syllabi for course requirements and attendance and participation expectations; check out the UTSA Bluebook • Be aware of important deadlines outlined in your syllabi and the semester academic calendar • Read UTSA Today and stay current with academic department/college news and Roadrunner Roadmap updates • Review the Student Policies publication and Handbook of Operating Procedures • Know your degree program requirements - refer to undergraduate and graduate catalogs and DegreeWorks for undergraduates • Apply for graduation and participate in commencement
STAY CONNECTED	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Participate in class; reach out and get to know your professors; form study groups • Meet with your undergraduate academic advisor or graduate advisor • Read your preferred email messages regularly and sign up for UTSA Alerts • Use the UTSA Mobile App and follow UTSA's official social media channels • Ask for assistance - Student Assistance Services, One Stop Enrollment Center, Graduation Help Desk • Remain in contact with family and friends; join the Family Association and the Alumni Association
BE ENGAGED	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Create profiles on RowdyLink and Handshake • Join a registered or sponsored student organization; participate in leadership and volunteer opportunities • Check out events hosted by the Student Union • Consider internship, experiential learning and Education Abroad opportunities • Share your thoughts, opinions and feedback with the Student Government Association • Follow the Student Code of Conduct and Roadrunner Pact; be an active bystander • Learn about marketable skills; build your social justice and equity leadership skills
UTILIZE RESOURCES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Utilize academic coaching, tutoring services, TutorMe (pilot initiative) and supplemental instruction • Get to know the UTSA libraries and Writing Center • Learn about Student Success Programs and Services, the Graduate School, PEACE Center and Child Development Center • Explore support services such as the Dreamers Resource Center, Center for Collegiate Recovery, Fostering Educational Success Center • Contact Testing Services for institutional and national testing for admission, placement and course credit purposes • Check out the Student Support Gateway and technology resources
SELF-CARE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use organizational tools to prioritize what you need to accomplish; notate important deadlines • Find healthy ways to relieve stress; participate in athletics and Campus Recreation activities and programs • Explore funding options such as assistantships, financial aid, Roadrunner Relief, scholarships and veteran educational benefits • Manage your finances; create a budget; qualify for a tuition rebate • Eat healthy; utilize the Roadrunner Pantry; learn about the UTSA Meal Share Program • Seek out Student Disability Services, Student Health Services and Counseling and Mental Health Services as needed • Use the LiveSafe App; safeguard your identity and belongings; report an incident • Consider alternative transportation options; learn more about the VIA U-Pass and Runner GPS App
