

# UTSA Academic Advising

## Learning Management System (LMS) Data in Inspire

Advisors will be able to access limited LMS data in Inspire. UTSA Advising will provide additional training soon.

A few key points on this new feature:

- LMS data is **highly predictive** of a student's likelihood to persist.
- Login data can be an indicator of a student's course **engagement**.
- In-progress grades may demonstrate that a **student needs support**.

Data Definitions:

- Grade/Avg- The first number listed is the student's current in-progress grade in the LMS gradebook. Inspire may only show a midterm Blackboard average.
- Unique Login Days/Avg- The first number listed is the **number of days the student has accessed the course** in the LMS since the start of the term. The second is the **average number of days of course access for all students** in the assigned section.




