

Fall 2016 Freshmen Orientation Scheduling Expectations

We thought it was in everyone's best interest to send out a reminder of the following fall 2016 course scheduling expectations for incoming freshmen as the focus of enrolling students in AIS courses is more about the 'right' AIS course. Meeting the expectations below is critical to facilitate students' timely progress toward their degree.

In those rare circumstances when these expectations cannot be met, a brief explanation should be made in the advising notes and an email sent to Kristi Johnson if a student had interest in a topic/section that is full. This will help with planning for the Spring and offering those topics of interest.

EXPECTATIONS

- A freshman planning to attend UTSA full-time is enrolled in at least 15 hours.
- A freshman with TSI deficiencies must address all deficiencies during the fall 2016 semester.
- All WRC 1013-ready freshmen should enroll in AIS 1203 + WRC 1013 during the fall 2016 term if that is the 'right' AIS course for the student until all available slots are filled at which point the student should be enrolled in UPM 1000.
- All WRC 1023-ready freshmen should enroll in AIS 1203 + WRC 1023 during the fall 2016 term if that is the 'right' AIS course for the student until all available slots are filled at which point the student should be enrolled in UPM 1000.
- A freshman entering UTSA with credit for both WRC 1013 and WRC 1023 should enroll in a stand-alone section of AIS 1203 during the fall 2016 term if that is the 'right' AIS course for the student until all available slots are filled at which point the student should be enrolled in UPM 1000.
- When a freshman is enrolled in UPM 1000 rather than AIS 1203 during the fall 2016 term, a comment (number) should be added in SPACMNT indicating why the student is not enrolled in AIS 1203 for the fall 2016 term, with comment type FYE:
 - (1) All AIS/WRC 1013 linked sections are filled
 - (2) All AIS/WRC 1023 linked sections are filled
 - (3) All standalone AIS sections are filled
 - (4) Student is not WRC 1013 ready
 - (5) The 'right' AIS course topic/section was full
- A freshman entering UTSA without college-credit for their core math course must enroll in the appropriate math core course during the fall 2016 term until all available slots are filled.
