

Coordinated Admission Program Requirements



CAP makes it possible for some freshman applicants to UT Austin to begin their studies at another UT System university. After completing CAP requirements during their freshman year, students transfer to UT Austin to complete their undergraduate studies.

Program Requirements

All requirements below must be met by the end of the spring semester to qualify for transfer to UT-Austin as a CAP student.

Semester Breakdown

Summer II: 6 credits (option of up to 7 credits if necessary)

Fall: 9 credits (option of up to 11 credits if necessary)

Spring 15 credits (spring may vary but credit hours for all three semesters must total at least 30 hours of CAP approved UTSA courses to meet CAP criteria)

Program Requirements

Students must complete 30 CAP approved credit hours, including an approved math course other than College Algebra.

Students must have a minimum 3.2 UTSA G.P.A. at the end of the spring semester.

Official UTSA transcripts will automatically be sent to UT-Austin for CAP students.
