Students, faculty, and staff are invited to learn more about the Fulbright Student Program, the educational exchange flagship program that sees thousands of students travel abroad following graduation to study in graduate programs, research, or teach English as a second language.

Description: Fulbrighters travel on 8-12 month programs that are fully funded by the US Department of State. Juniors, seniors, and graduate students who will have graduated by Spring 2025 are especially encouraged to attend. Graduate students who want to conduct research abroad for their dissertation can also apply. Base eligibility for the program is that you are a US citizen. There is no minimum GPA and prior foreign travel is not required.

Refreshments: Following the presentation, pizza will be served and students will have an opportunity to talk to Fulbright staff, the ambassadors and UTSA staff from The Office of Nationally Competitive Awards and UTSA Study Abroad.
