Spring 2017: GER 2333 German Literature in English Translation

TR 1:00-2:15 Instructor: Christopher Wickham

This course examines magic spells, heroic epic narratives, courtly love poetry, writings of Luther, the Faust tale, and comic plays by Hans Sachs from the German literary tradition. It covers literature and culture from the Middle Ages to 1700.



This course is taught in English and meets the requirements for the UTSA Core Curriculum LITERATURE domain (catalogs up to 2012-14) and LANGUAGE, PHILOSOPHY, CULTURE (Fall 2014 catalog onward).

It addresses literary terminology, important texts, themes, myths, characters, periods and genres from the European tradition.

The course is taught parallel with GER 3413. No more than 3 credits may be earned for the course.
