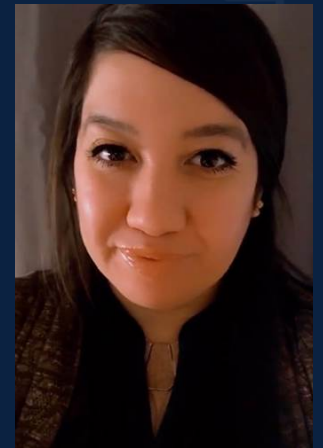

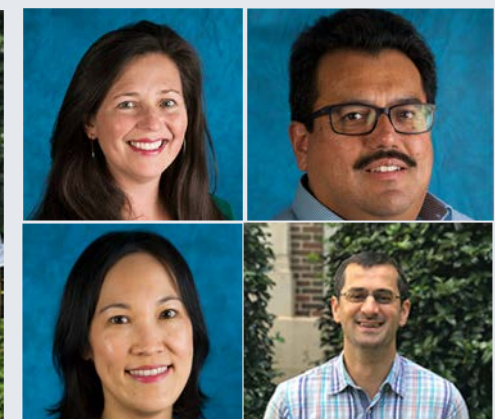

2021-2022 Highlights

- Faculty received approximately \$2 million in grant funding.
- Grant funding provides financial support/training for approximately 130 masters students over the course of several years.
- Awarded a second consecutive Dept. of Ed OSEP grant entitled DEEP impact in Texas (\$260,000). Training grant designed to co educate Teachers of the Deaf and School Psychology masters students will fund/partially support a total of 20 School Psych scholars over the next 5 years.
- EDP faculty received grant for “Project EARLY”. Which is \$1.2 million, 5-year grant to prepare our School Psychology and Applied Behavior Analysis students to work with very young children at-risk or diagnosed with autism.
- EDP faculty published in field-specific high impact journals including Journal of Educational Psychology (Dr. Thacker) and Journal of Applied Behavior Analysis (Dr. MacNaul).
- We had a successful new faculty hire of Associate Professor Dr. Davis for our School Psychology PhD program.
- Faculty publications in high impact journals including *Journal of Educational Psychology* and *Journal of Applied Behavior Analysis*.
- Dr. Nichols survived her second year as Chair having started during COVID!
