Please park in BK1 lot in front of the Convocation Center. The shuttle is leaving promptly at 8:30 a.m. Please be sure to bring your regalia with you; you do NOT have to already be dressed in your regalia.
8:45 a.m.	Shuttle Service to Alamodome from Downtown Campus (you may take either Campus shuttle)	Faculty report to the Frio Street Circle drive to board the shuttle provided to the Alamodome. Please park wherever your current permit allows you to park. The shuttle is leaving promptly at 8:45 a.m. Please be sure to bring your regalia with you; you do NOT have to already be dressed in your regalia.
9:00 a.m.	Arrival at South Entrance Loading Dock of Alamodome	To ensure the safety of every guest and graduate, all persons will be subject to a bag check and security scan. Faculty will be directed through the Southeast Tunnel to check-in at the Faculty Participants room in meeting room C/D. Volunteers will direct faculty. Personal items will be checked there for security reasons.

10:00 a.m.	Processional	A UTSA Ambassador will instruct you.
10:10 a.m.	Posting of the banners/mace	Remain standing
10:20 a.m.	Greetings	Remain seated
10:30 a.m.	Speaker	Remain seated
11:00 a.m.	Presentation of Graduates	The Dean of each College will ask those who are candidates for degrees in that College to stand. The degrees will be conferred. The Master of Ceremonies will request graduates to approach the stage. One row will rise at a time, as directed by a UTSA Ambassador and proceed to the stage. Doctoral students will be hooded on stage. When the announcer calls the graduate's name, the graduate will proceed across the stage to receive the scroll and congratulations from the Dean. The graduate will then file off the stage and be congratulated by the faculty participants from that college. A UTSA Ambassador/Staff Volunteer will instruct the faculty to stand and congratulate the students.
