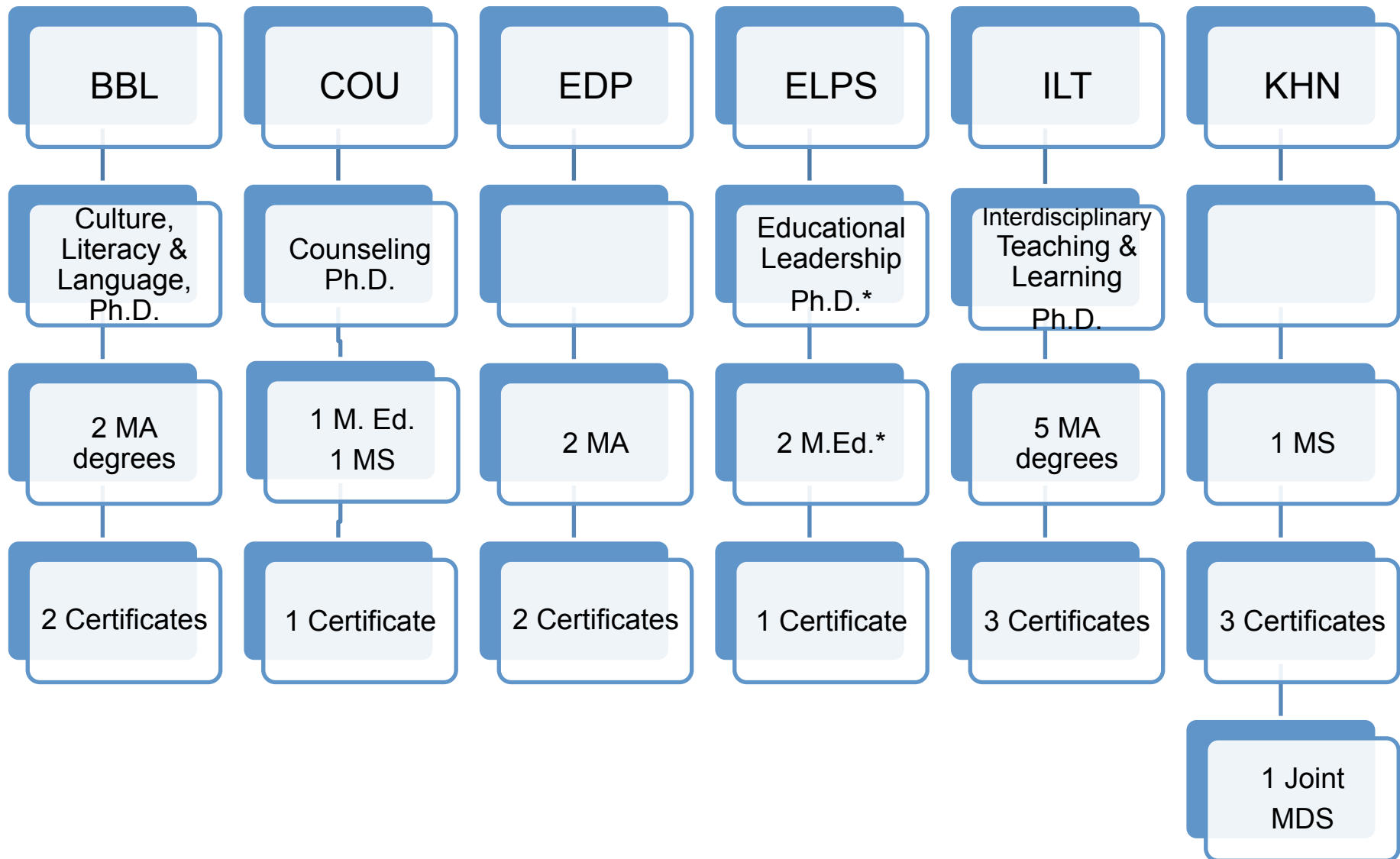

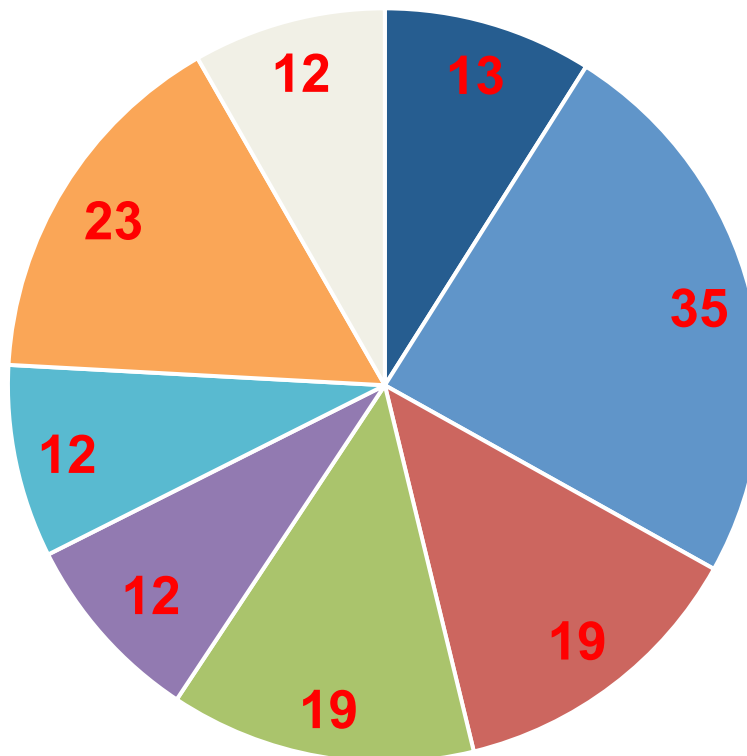

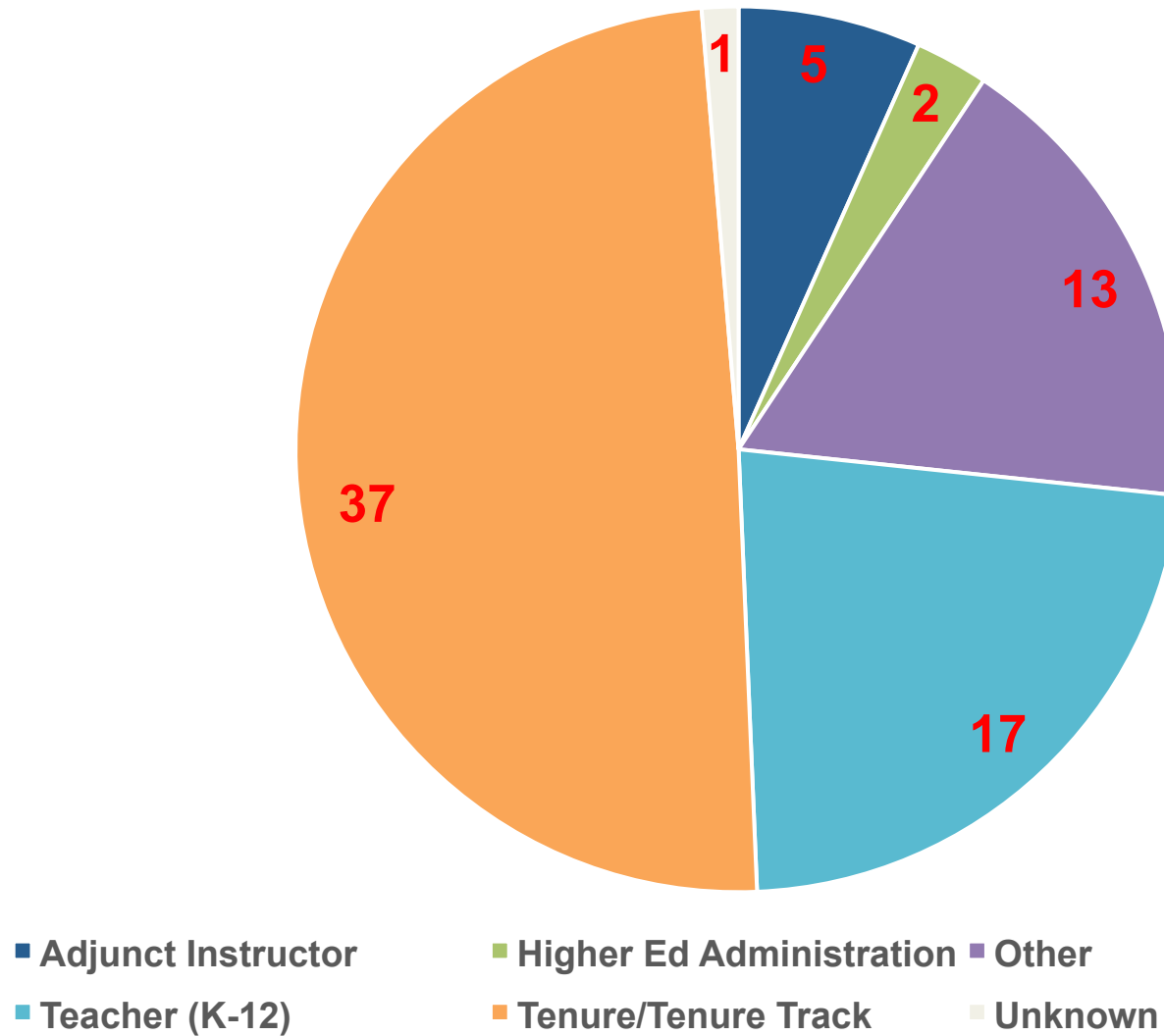

Doctor of Education in Educational Leadership Established Spring 1999 - 145 Graduates

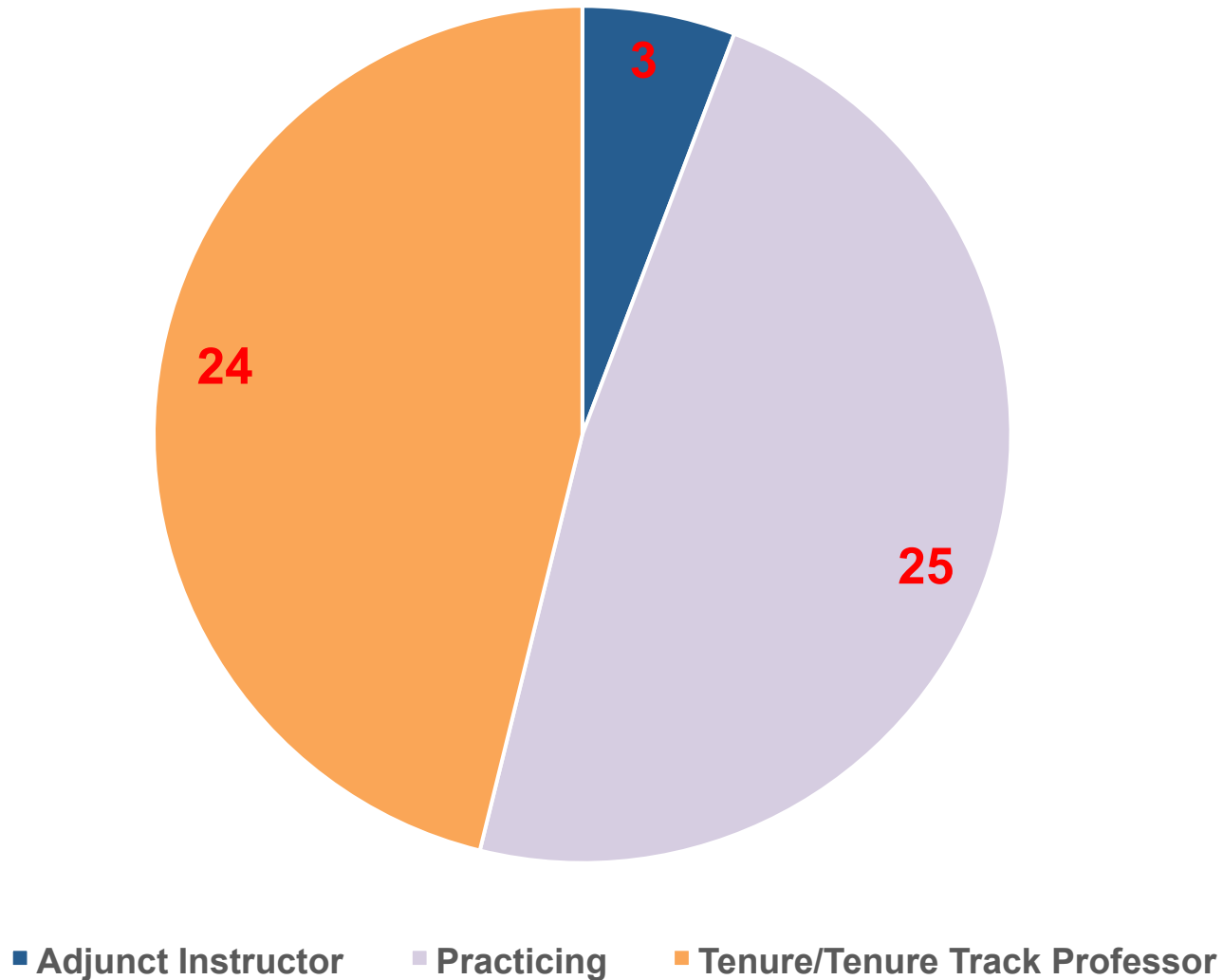

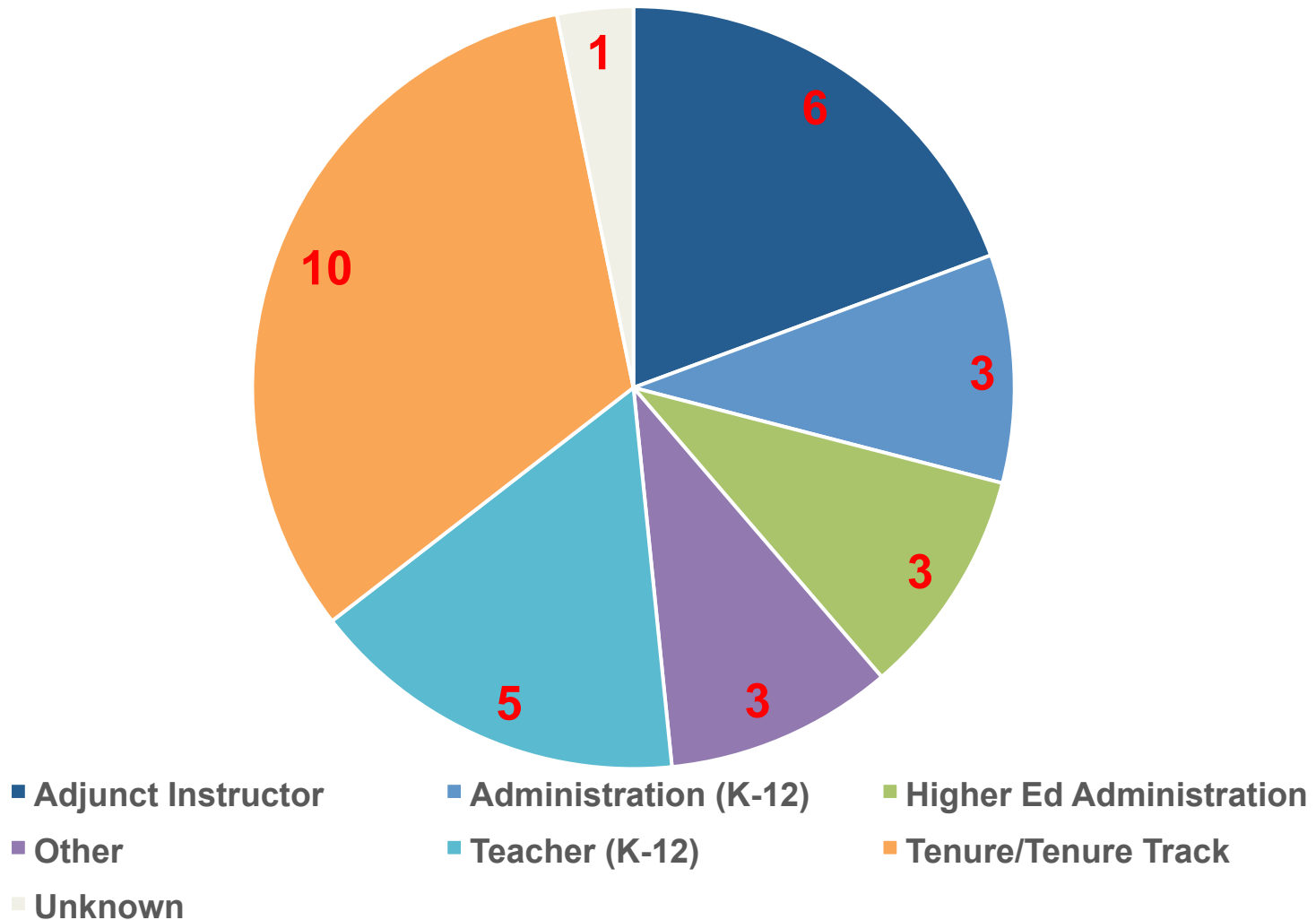
Doctor of Philosophy in Culture Literacy and Language Established Fall 2001 - 75 Graduates

Doctor of Philosophy in Interdisciplinary Learning and Teaching Established Fall 2009 - 25 Graduates



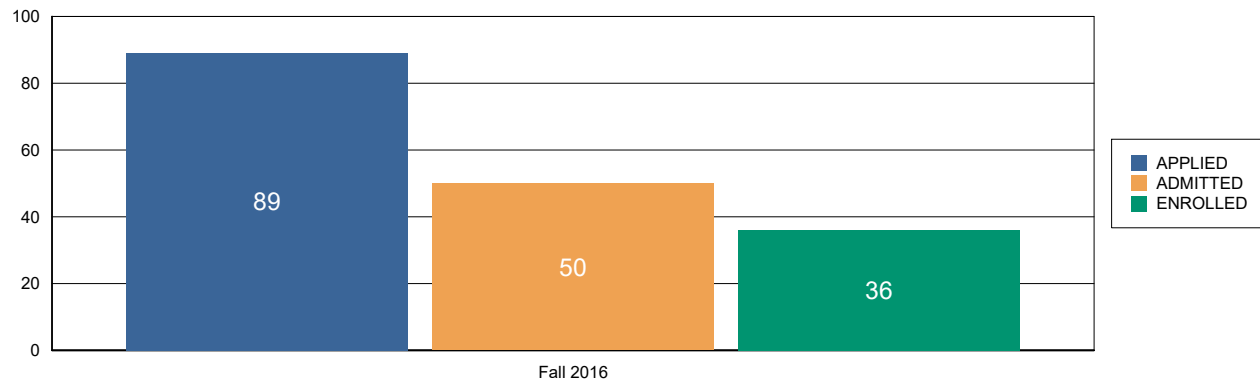

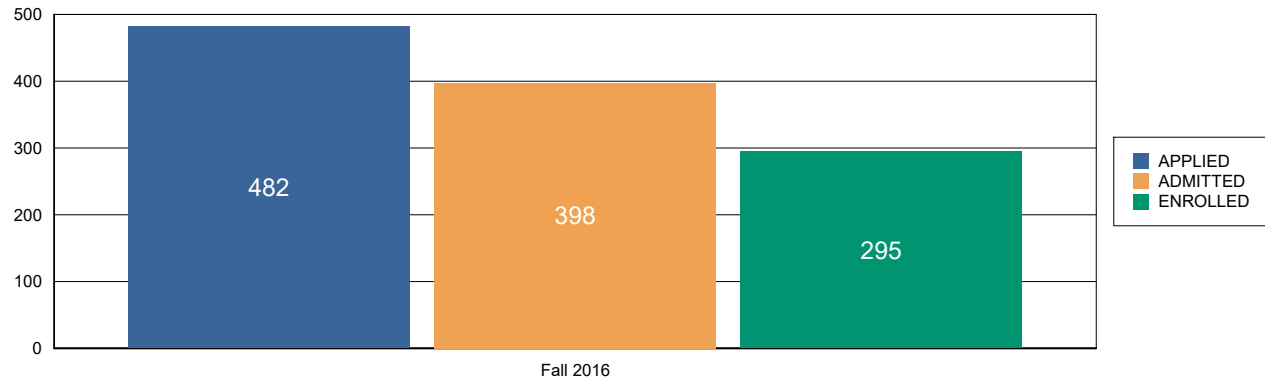

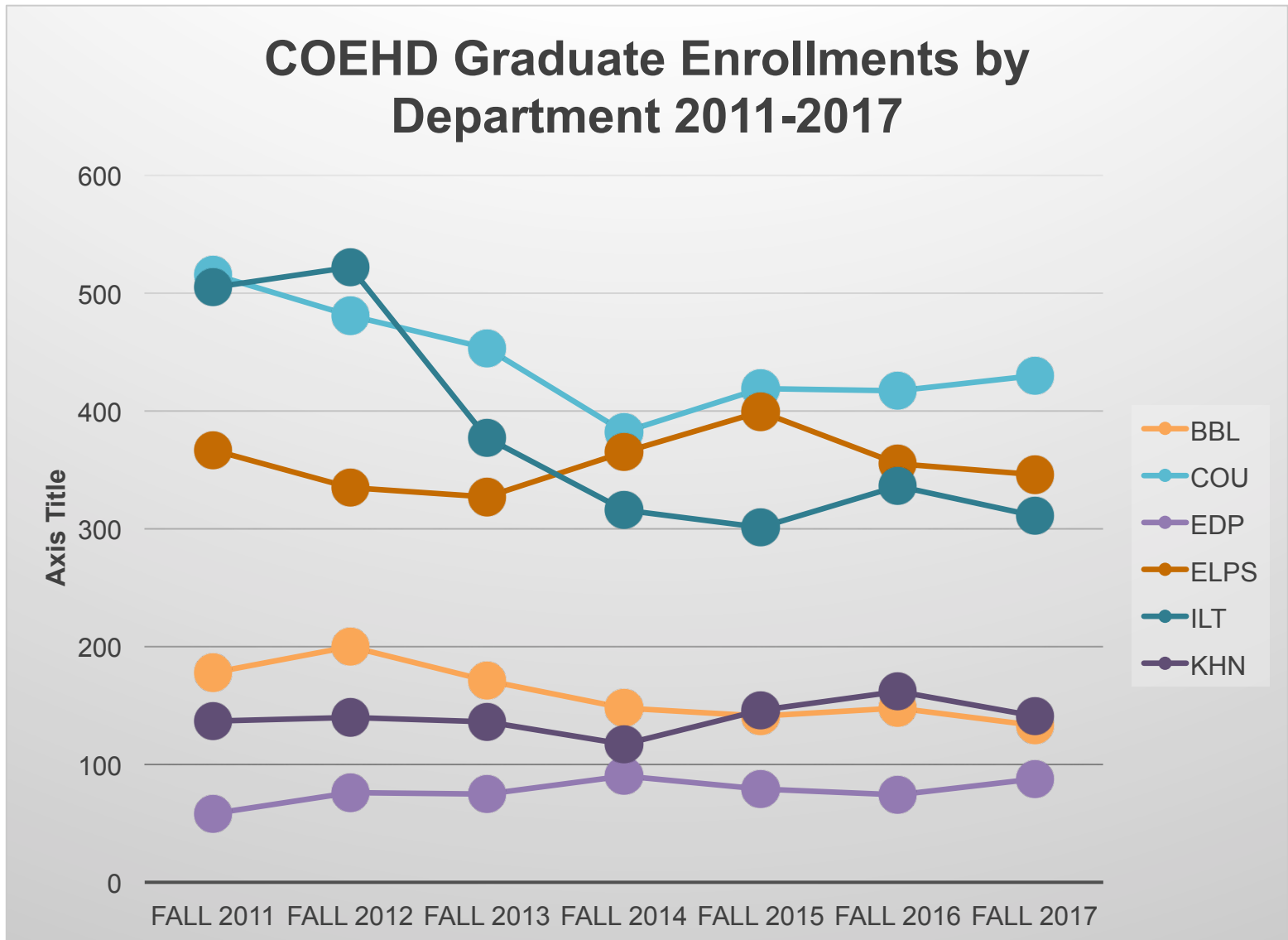
Yield Rates Master's COEHD – Fall 2016

COEHD Graduate Enrollments by Department 2011-2017



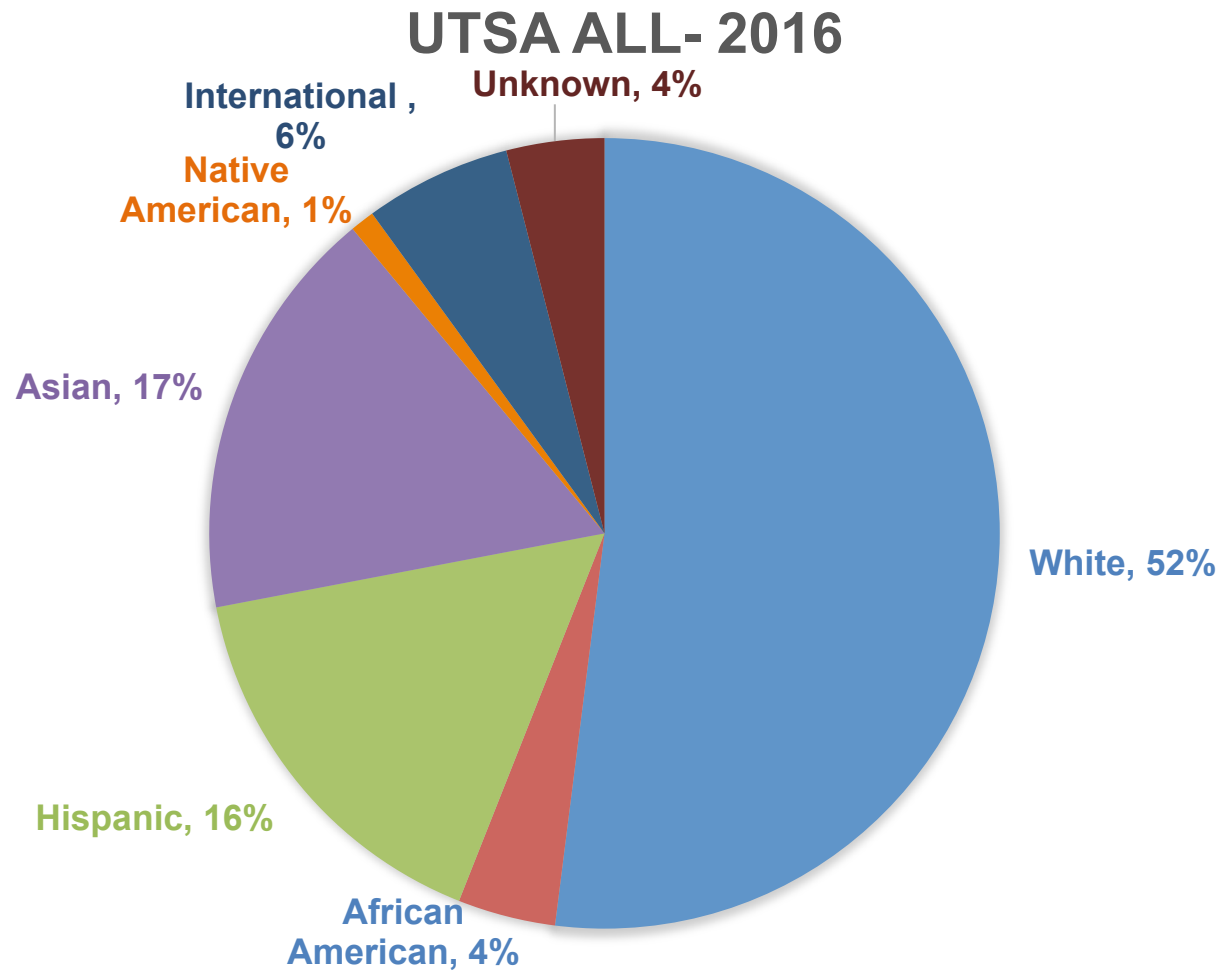
