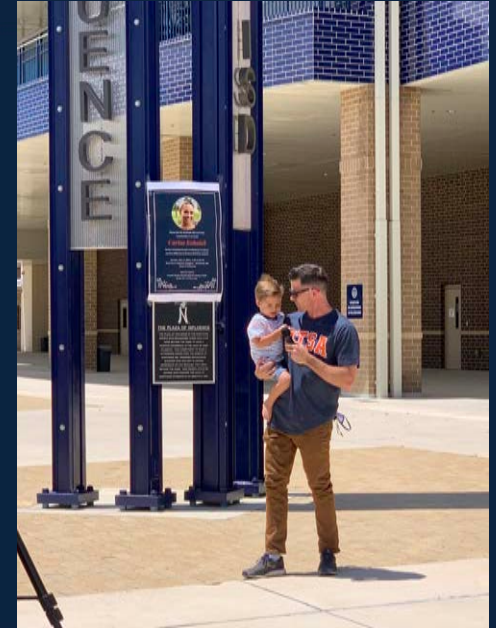

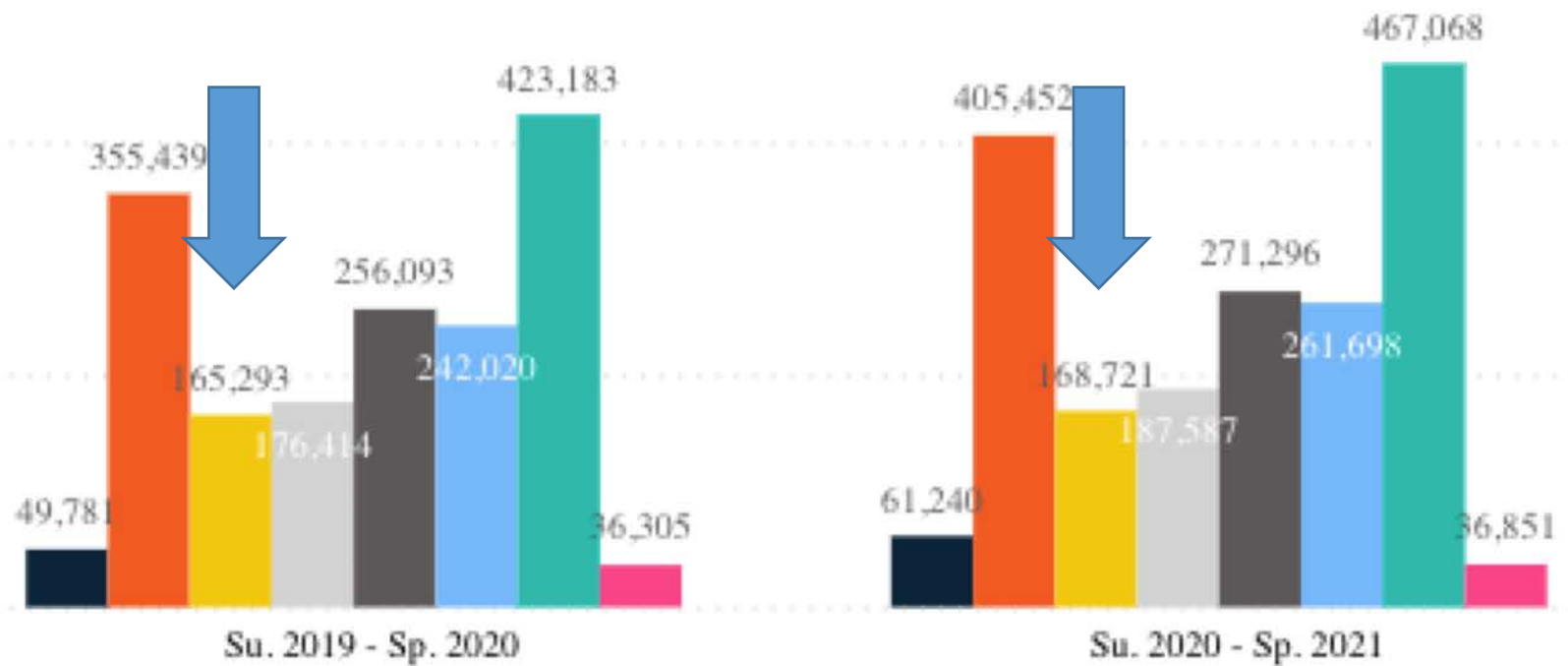

Budget - IRMY22

Budget is determined through activity drivers

- WSCH, SCH, staff size, research expenditures etc.
- 2021-2022 budget is based on actual activity in 2020-2021, and is determined ***as % share of activity across University***

Budget In a nutshell:

- COEHD's WSCH and SCH have increased slightly, but % share of WSCH and SCH has decreased relative to other colleges.
- We will have decreased instructional revenue for next year - however, COEHD Fees and Research/Endowment funds have increased both in amount and in percent share: this will offset some of this loss in revenue.
- Budget planning for next year, including discussions of how to prioritize Faculty new hires, staffing, FTT allocations, and M&O allocations are on-going.

Summer

- Campus is open, offices are available
- Limit large meetings and guests
- Keep an eye on the health task force messages and the President's messages
- Continue to engage in social distancing and other measures to keep yourselves and community safe
- The Public Health Task Force is working on a vaccination drive and updated health plan in light of the Governor's mandate

Summer Moving: Imagining Community Through Space Reconfiguration

Aims of leadership:

- Building cohesion through co-located space
- Thinking creatively about space in light of planned growth
 - Hotelling, shared space, adapted work modalities

Space issues:

- Monterrey Building shut-down
 - Three COEHD units moving out
- Psychology and English department swap (affecting MB space)
- REGSS new office opening downtown

Planning:

- Department Chairs will receive their space allocations next week
- Moving plans will be communicated prior to May 31 for faculty who wish to pack their own belongings prior to being off contract.
- All materials for those moving must be packed and labelled by June 30.
 - Packing materials will be made available.
 - Professional movers will handle the big moves.

Fall Modalities and Fall Work Plan

- Primary concept: what works best for achieving mission
 - Plans submitted
 - Flexibility is key
 - Plans will be reviewed regularly
 - In the Fall continued discussion of work modalities as well as course modalities for Spring

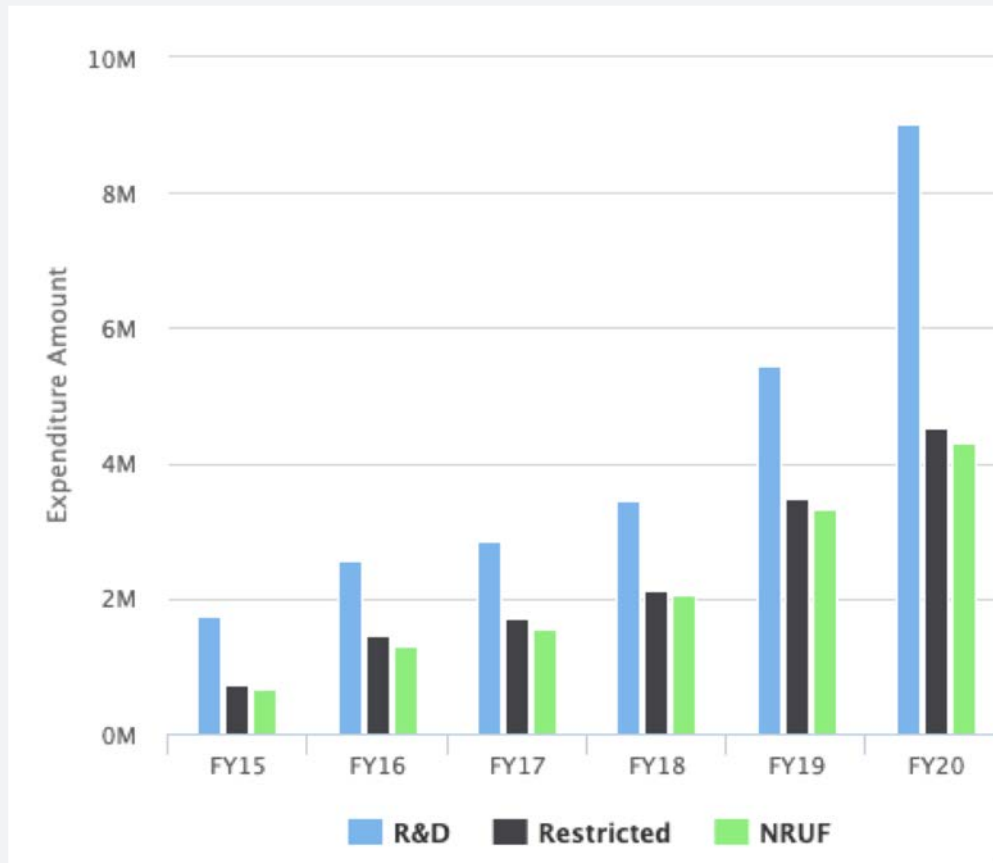

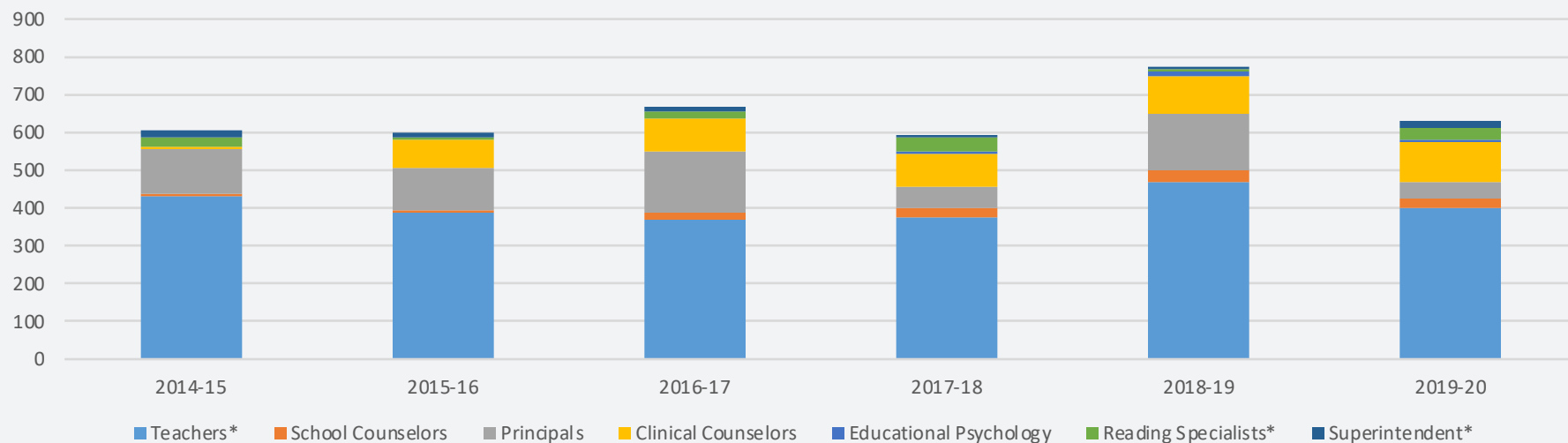

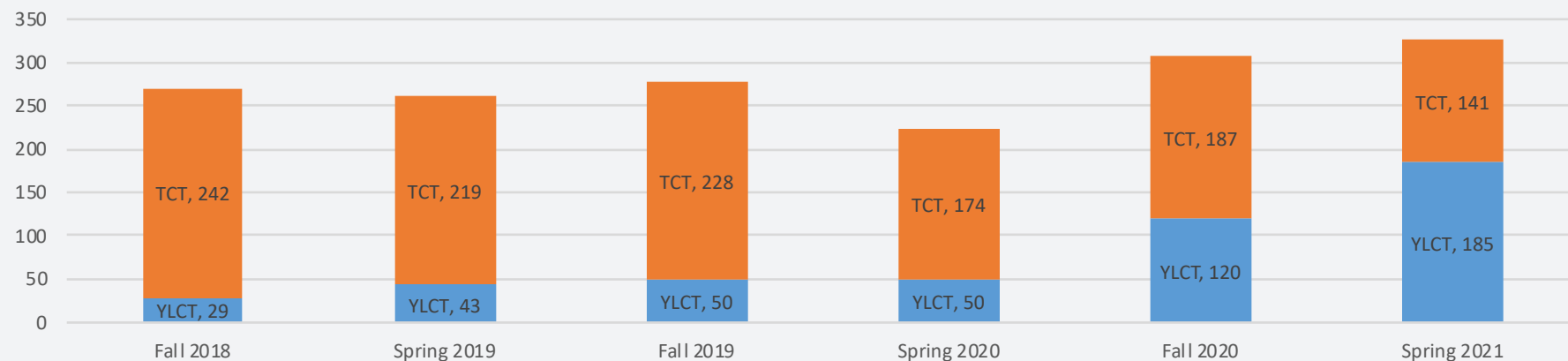
