- Three credit hours will be earned from Chang'an University and may be transferred back to UTSA (e.g., KAH6973, BBL6973, or EDL6973)
- Students are responsible for applying for a passport/visa to study at Chang'an University as well as paying for UTSA International Program fee/travel insurance
- Weekend outing expenses of students' choice are not included
- Application deadline: **February 5, 2016**; Space is limited, so please apply early!
