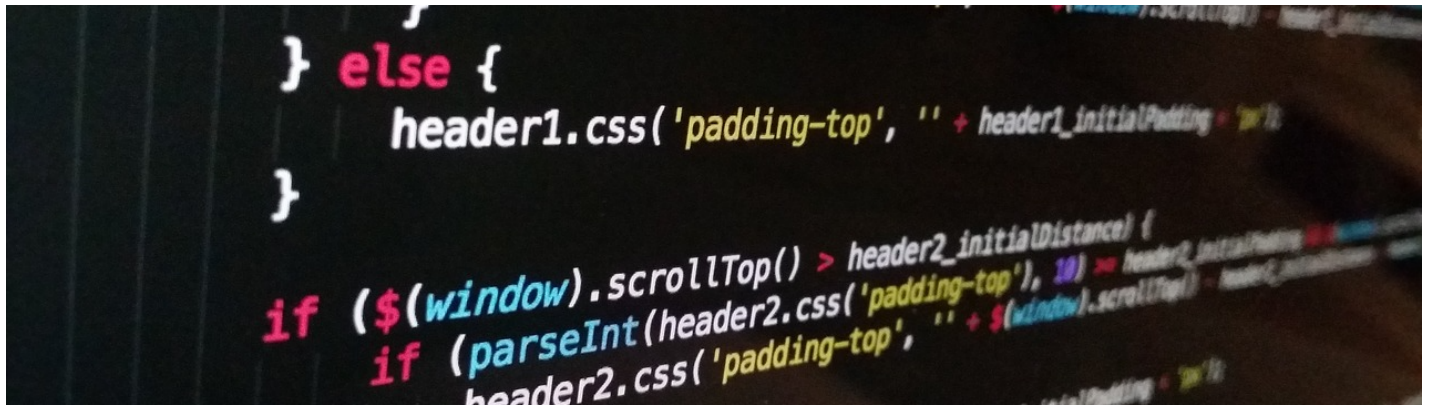


PROGRAMMING BOOTCAMP

The **Programming Bootcamp for UTSA Pre-Service Teachers** is a two-hour introduction to programming in Python. This workshop is targeted towards pre-service secondary teachers. Participants will learn foundational programming concepts and how to read and write basic programs. Programming will mostly be taught within mathematics contexts, mostly in algebra, geometry, and trigonometry. By the end of this workshop, participants will be able to write simple programs to solve common mathematical problems. No previous programming experience is required!
