

THE COEHD Presidential Scholarship*

APPLICATION DEADLINE: May 15, 2014

The COEHD Presidential Scholarship has been established with Presidential School Funds from the Office President, Dr. Romo. **This is a Competitive Scholarship** open to ALL COEHD majors' undergraduates and Master level students. This scholarship is not renewable; however, if additional funds become available, recipients are encouraged to re-apply. Recipients will be known as Presidential Scholars. **COEHD students in a doctoral program are NOT eligible to apply.**

To be eligible for this scholarship applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Must be **currently** enrolled at UTSA as a full-time student: at least 12 credit hours for undergraduates and 9 hours for Master level students.
- Must have a declared major in the UTSA College of Education and Human Development.
- Entering freshmen must have a minimum SAT score of 1090 and/or a minimum ACT score of 24 and a minimum cumulative high school GPA of 3.0.
- Undergraduates and Graduate (Master level) students must have at least a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- At the time of application, must have completed at least one semester at UTSA at the current classification level.
- Must submit a completed application and required essay by the application deadline date indicated above.
