OUR MISSION:

To support and retain talented researchers by providing dedicated time, mentored training, and protected research experience on the path to research independence.



WHO CAN APPLY?

- Currently enrolled in a PhD or equivalent research degree program (e.g., EngD, DNSc, DrPH, DSW, PharmD, ScD) in the biomedical, behavioral, or clinical sciences at an eligible institution
- Commitment to a career in research
- U.S. citizen, non-citizen national, or permanent resident



WHAT DOES IT SUPPORT?

The F99/K00 provides up to 5 years of support across two consecutive phases.

- **F99 Phase (Predoctoral):** Provides 1 to 2 years of mentored research training to support completion of the research doctorate, including final experiments, dissertation preparation, and selection of a postdoctoral mentor.
- **K00 Phase (Postdoctoral):** Provides up to 3 years of mentored postdoctoral research and career development support, contingent upon successful completion of the doctoral degree requirements.
